This month's topic is Nature and the children will be encouraged to engage in a nature walk around the garden to observe their environment, insects and plants. We will also be planting seeds and we will be measuring and observing the development of the seed over time. Our water tray will be full of leaves, grass and other natural resources that the children can collect from our garden. The children are invited to bring their own natural resources in to add to our sensory box from walks or visits they may have outside of nursery from weekend days out. We will also be creating our very own footprint/handprint nature paintings.
